## **Notes About Additional Sources**

- 1. Relatively complete sets of City Council minutes, ordinances and resolutions can be found in the Council's storage room in the basement of city hall under the jurisdiction of City Clerk Dianna Thompson (717-849-2246; dthompson@yorkcity.org).
- 2. Many historic records of the executive branch of city government (Mayor's office, etc.) dating primarily from the incorporation of York as a city in 1887 and later, such as police records, tax assessment books, lot and subdivision plans, ordinance books, early-twentieth-century mayor's correspondence, maps, real estate records, etc. are located in a large storage room in the basement of city hall under the jurisdiction of Mike Shanabrook, Director of Emergency Management (717-849-2441; mshanabrook@yorkcity.org). These records are generally grouped by type, but require additional arrangement. While no inventory of this material is available, Mr. Shanabrook has extensive and detailed knowledge of the materials and their location in the room.
- 3. The Library of the YCHC holds miscellaneous materials, c.1812-c.1973, received from the city over the years, which are found in files 00117.002, 00117.005, 00117.006, 00117.007, 00117.016, 00117.028, 00117.035. Of special note is a 1934 WPA "Survey of Municipal Archives" in file 00117.035 that lists the city's records as they were found at that time.
